<u>OUR PARISH HISTORY</u> - On Monday 31 July 1933 Rev. Mother Mary of the Cross (Elizabeth Hutchinson as she was before she entered the Church), for 31 years the Superior of the Birstall Convent of the Sisters of Charity of the Order of St Paul the Apostle, and headmistress at St. Patrick's, died unexpectedly as a result of a heart attack. On Sunday she had appeared well, attending mass and playing the harmonium at the children's service. She took friends to Oakwell Hall that afternoon, and also attended evening benediction. She was taken ill during the night. (Jane Roberts - Parish Historian)
