THE DIVINE MERCY DEVOTION - SLIGHT CHANGE OF PLAN - Having listened to your concerns about coming out on a night time, I have decided to change the times of the Divine Mercy Devotion in order to;

Also, for St Patrick's, when it is the last Tuesday on the month, the 12.00noon Mass will move to 2.00pm in order to combine with the Divine Mercy. *Thank you for your understanding.*
