OUR PARISH HISTORY - October and November 1860 marked the first burials recorded in the St Mary's parish register. The first entry is dated 10 October, for 21-year-old Margaret Brannon of Birstall, who died on 7 October. She was buried in Birstall. The next entry is dated 3 November 1860 for 65-year-old Elizabeth Downs of Staincliffe who died on 30 October. The third is dated 21 November 1860, for 21-year-old Mary Berry of Batley who died on 18 November. She was interred in the graveyard at Batley Parish Church, which was the town's cemetery before the 1866 opening of Batley Cemetery.

"I have spoken to Safer Leeds today [19th September 2024] (joint police, council and other organisations body) and there are no changes to dates or information. If buffer zones are imposed on the 31st of October, we will just relocate for the final four days."
