The program shines a light on everyday heroes within society by painting portraits of them. These everyday heroes have extraordinary stories and the artists hope to turn these stories into amazing portraits. These portraits are in an exhibition at the Loading Bay in Bradford from March 13 to April 6. The theme of HOPE throughout was both humbling and inspiring. This matches the Jubilee Year theme of hope.

<u>OUR PARISH HISTORY</u> - On 27 March 1926 Patrick Higgins, on his sixth attempt, was elected as a Birstall District Councillor. Described as a real "son of the people" he had a keen interest in welfare, equity and justice, framed by his own experiences. Prior to his election, as president of Birstall Unemployment Association, he was praised for his work in relieving distress in the town, making representations to the Council about relief schemes and championing the unemployed. He was also secretary of Birstall Boots for Bairns Fund, and a member of the Birstall Trades and Labour Council. Between 1914-1923 he was on the committee of the Birstall Industrial Cooperative Society representing them at Congress on the Hours and Wages Board. An active member of St Patrick's church and the Irish community, he was the president of Birstall Catholic Young Men's Society and Institute, an official of the Birstall Irish Democratic League Club, and secretary of the Birstall Branch of the Irish National Foresters.
