#### **THE READINGS FOR PALM SUNDAY**

On Palm Sunday the lectionary readings focus on the Passion of Christ and His triumphant yet humble entry into Jerusalem. **Gospel at the Procession (Luke 19:28-40):** Jesus enters Jerusalem riding on a colt, greeted by crowds joyfully proclaiming Him as king. This sets the tone of praise and expectation.

**First Reading (Isaiah 50:4-7):** The Suffering Servant speaks of enduring abuse and humiliation with steadfast faith in God, foreshadowing Christ's Passion.

**Responsorial Psalm (Psalm 22):** A cry of anguish and trust in God amidst suffering, echoing Jesus' words on the cross.

**Second Reading (Philippians 2:6-11):** Paul presents Christ's humility in becoming human and obedient to death, leading to His exaltation by God.

**Passion Gospel (Luke 22:14-23:56 or 23:1-49):** The detailed account of Jesus' Last Supper, betrayal, trial, crucifixion, and burial. Luke emphasizes Jesus' innocence, compassion, and forgiveness even amidst great suffering
