PARISH HISTORY – On 12th July 1934 Father Godfrey Hunt died in New York. The tenth of Patrick Hunt and wife Mary Kilkenny's 11 children, he was born in Birstall in 1878 as Patrick Hunt, the family subsequently moving to Batley. After completing his education at Glastonbury college, the St Mary's parishioner left England for the Franciscan Mount St Sepulchre Monastery in Washington, becoming an American citizen in 1901. From there he moved to the Holy Land to train as a Franciscan, being received into the Order in 1903. In 1908 he was ordained as a priest in Jerusalem. He served as a Chaplain with the Americans in the First World War, and afterwards he returned to the Holy Land, acting as a liaison officer between British authorities, and Muslim and Jewish officials to ensure the safety of the Holy Places, guiding pilgrims and becoming a Counsellor of the Franciscan Custody of the Holy Places. He made regular visits to his family in Batley, and on his death a solemn requiem mass was celebrated at St Mary's.
