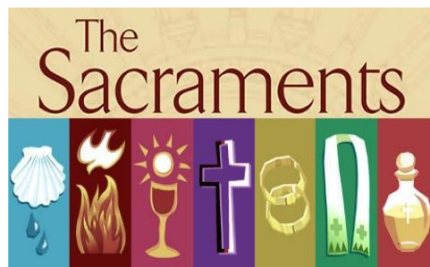

**PARISH HISTORY** - 9<sup>th</sup> July 1932 marked the death of St. Patrick's parishioner, and the former caretaker of Birstall Roman Catholic Day Schools, Mrs. Mary Sunman. Born in County Durham, and the widow of Hull mason John Sunman, she came to Birstall in around 1890. Appointed the school caretaker ten years later, it was a job she held for 22 years. She was then succeeded by her daughter, widow Mrs. Ellen Doyle, who was still in that role at the time of her mother's death. The funeral was held at Birstall Parish Church, in a service conducted by St. Patrick's priest Father J. O'Sullivan.
